Fiona came into public service to try to make a difference to people's lives and still holds true to this principle today.

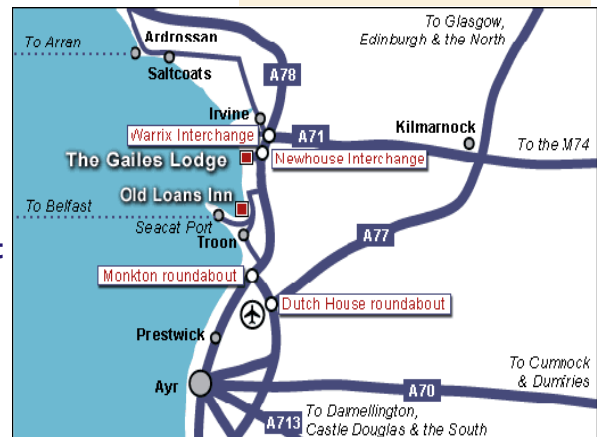
